The Board of Appeal and Equalization for Avon Township will meet on Monday, April 20, 2020, 7:00 – 7:30 PM, at the Avon Township Hall (16881 Queens Road, Avon, MN). The purpose of this meeting is to determine whether property in the jurisdiction has been properly valued and classified by the assessor.

If you believe the value or classification of your property is incorrect, please contact your assessor's office to discuss your concerns. If you disagree with the valuation and classification after discussing it with your assessor, you may appear before the local board of appeal and equalization. The board will review your assessments and may make corrections as needed. Generally, you must appeal to the local board before appealing to the county board of appeal and equalization. The Avon Township Hall is handicap-accessible.

This meeting will be a teleconference to avoid any public gatherings at this time. It will still be held at the same time and date as advertised on value notices. Information on how to participate will be posted at the Town Hall and the Township website. Any appeals are asked to be e-mailed to the Assessor's Office at property.assessment@co.stearns.mn.us.
