

Avon Township Planning Board
December 30, 2008
Avon City Hall

The monthly meeting of the Planning Board was called to order by Chairman, Ken Mergen at 8:00 PM. Everyone stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Present – Lowell Rushmeyer, Roger Nelson, Ken Mergen, Gerry Kremers. Steve Saupe was absent. Renee Smith was the acting clerk.

Agenda: Additions as follows: Members of the Angulski family may come at 8:15 to discuss a certificate of compliance. Information on the Blattner wind turbine project and the township role there. Motion to approve the agenda made by Mergen, seconded by Kremers.

Minutes: Motion by Mergen, seconded by Nelson, to approve the minutes of the last meeting. All in favor, motion carried.

The board members examine the draft of an ordinance for large gatherings which Saupe has prepared. Saupe has gone through the county ordinance and chosen parts relevant to the township. Members did not feel they had enough time to do a thorough job at this meeting. Motion by Nelson, seconded by Mergen, to table the ordinance discussion until the next meeting. They will study the draft and discuss changes at that time.

Mergen found out, by phone, that Angulski's may want to re-build the old farm house on their property. They did not attend the meeting.

Gondringer spoke with Don Adams concerning the procedure followed in the hearing for the Blattner project. Adams is OK with it and said the MOU is not a legal document, but an administrative one. But, the township needs to review the language used to see if it could be changed to make the MOU more clear. Motion by Nelson, seconded by Mergen, to insure that every member has a copy of the MOU for review and discuss any changes at the next meeting.

Motion by Rushmeyer, seconded by Kremers, to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 9:00 PM.
