Minutes of the Meeting of the Avon Township Appeals & Equalization Board

<u>Call to Order</u>: Chairman Bresnahan called the meeting of the Avon Township Appeals and Equalization Board to order at 7:00 P.M.

Pedge of Allegiance: The pledge of allegiance was recited

<u>Roll Call</u>: Present – Richard Bresnahan, John Merdan, and Roger Nelson. Also present: Stephen Saupe, Avon Township Clerk, and Stearns County Assessors Kathy Korte and Tina Diedrich-Von Eschen

Business:

- 1. **Welcome & Procedures** Bresnahan outlined the process for the meeting. Decisions are made at the end of the meeting after all cases are heard and all pertinent information is obtained.
- 2. **Sales Summary** Ms. Korte provided a summary of sales in the Township. Residential properties increased by 6% while seasonal/recreational properties showed no change. Agricultural land increased 7 14% (average 7%), commercial increased 2%, apartments showed no change, and Green Acres increased 12 20% (average 17%).
- 3. **Scegura** Mr. Ray Scegura appeared to request a reevaluation and decrease of the assessed value of two properties (PID 03.00850.0000 & 03.00854.0000). After examining and discussing available evidence, Merdan moved that no change be made in the assessments for Mr. Ray Scegura. Nelson second. All in favor. Motion carried.
- 4. **Kulas** Mr. Dan Kulas appeared to request a reevaluation and decrease of the assessed value of his property (PID 03.00721.000). After examining and discussing available evidence, Nelson moved that no change be made in the assessments for Mr. Dan Kulas. Merdan second. All in favor. Motion carried.
- 5. **Spanier** Mr. Scott Spanier sent a letter to the Assessor's Office requesting a reevaluation and decrease of the assessed value of his property. Based on similar sales and some unique features of the property, Merdan moved to lower the assessment from \$213,000 to \$187,000. Nelson second. All in favor. Motion carried.
- 6. **Studniski** Mr. Tom Studniski sent a letter to Assessor's Office requesting a change in the designation of his property (PID 03.00959.0000) to agriculture since it is grazed and pastured. Merdan moved to change the property classification to agriculture. Nelson second. All in favor. Motion carried.

<u>Adjournment</u>: Merdan moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:08 PM. Nelson second. All in favor. Motion carried.
