# **Avon Township Board of Audit Meeting Minutes** February 10, 2016

**Call to order** – Supervisor Richard Bresnahan called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM in the main chamber of the Avon Town Hall, 16881 Queens Road, Avon (MN).

Pledge of Allegiance – The pledge was recited.

**Recording of Meeting** – There was an announcement that the meeting would be recorded and then the recorder was turned on.

**Roll Call** – Present: Richard Bresnahan, John Merdan, Roger Nelson, Kelly Martini, and Stephen Saupe. Also present: Marion Gondringer (Deputy Clerk), Paul Buttweiler (Deputy Treasurer)

**Approval of agenda** – Nelson moved to approve the agenda as presented. Merdan second. All in favor. Motion carried. A typo was discovered in the minutes from the 2015 Audit Board meeting – Supervisor Nelson's name should have been listed below the signature line.

# **Scheduled Business**

- 1. **Examination of Claims** The Supervisors audited the claims. The following claims were randomly selected. These are listed in Table 1. The claims were found to be in order. All were allowed. Merdan moved to accept the audit of the randomly selected claims. Nelson second. All in favor. Motion carried.
- Examine / Audit Town Accounts The financial records separately maintained by the Treasurer and by the Clerk (Deputy Clerk) were examined and compared. The numbers from the two independently maintained records were identical. Nelson moved to accept the financial records maintained by the Treasurer and Clerk (Deputy Clerk). Merdan second. All in favor. Motion carried. The Cash Control Summary Statements from 2015 maintained independently by both the Treasurer and Clerk (Deputy Clerk) are appended below.
- 3. **Bank Account Audit** The bank records maintained by the Treasurer and Clerk (Deputy Clerk) were compared and matched. Nelson moved to approve the audit of the bank records maintained by the Treasurer and Clerk (Deputy Clerk). There are currently some outstanding checks. These will be examined at the next Supervisor meeting.
- 4. **Budget for 2017** After examining the disbursements and receipts for 2015, the Supervisors determined the budget amounts for 2017 (Table 3).
- Levy for 2017 Analyzing the financial status of the Township the Supervisors determined the levy amounts for 2017 (Table 2). The levy amounts for 2017 that will be recommended to the residents for approval at the Annual Meeting are: General Revenue - \$155,000; Road & Bridge - \$199,100; Fire - \$68,000; Capital Reserve - \$2,000 for a total levy of \$424,100 (Table 2). With the exception of the 2016 levy in which Township residents voted at the

Annual Meeting to add an additional \$2,000 to the levy for the control of aquatic invasive species, the levy total recommended by the Supervisors has not changed in more than five years. Merdan moved to approve and recommend to the residents at the Annual Meeting a total levy of \$424,100, with General Revenue - \$155,000; Road & Bridge - \$199,100; Fire - \$68,000; and Capital Reserve - \$2,000. Nelson second. All in favor. Motion carried.

- 6. **Financial Report** The results of the audit were summarized in the Audit Board Report for 2016.
- 7. Roles of Treasurer & Clerk To maintain a system of checks and balances, the Clerk receives most claims and receipts and supplies them to the Treasurer. Any claims or receipts first obtained by the Treasurer are shared with the Clerk. The Treasurer handles payment and record keeping. The Deputy Clerk audits all transactions. At each meeting, the Supervisors examine and approve the claims and payroll. Receipts will be made in triplicate. Nelson moved to approve the current method of maintaining Township checks and balances. Merdan second. All in favor. Motion carried.
- 8. **Adjournment** Merdan moved to adjourn at 9:32 PM. Nelson second. All in favor. Motion carried.
