Review of 2022 Calls and Hours and Financial Report

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Fire Board meeting was duly held at City Hall on the 9th day of February 2022 at 7:00 pm.

Minutes were reviewed. No changes or additions were noted.

Motion Guggenberger to approve minutes second Huston and carried unanimously.

Avon Fire Relief Association Corey Nellis gave an update on the Relief Association's financial status. Looking forward a \$58,092 surplus is expected at the end of 2022 if the yearly benefit amount were to remain at the current \$2,500 level. Relief Association Treasurer Corey Nellis made a request to consider an increase in the yearly benefit to \$2,600. This would not impact the annual contribution amount from each entity.

Corey Nellis and Chuck Swenson explained the makeup of the department and who is becoming eligible for retirement. They also explained that it may become more difficult to attract firefighters to the department as time goes on.

Motion by Guggenberger to increase the annual benefit amount from \$2,500 to \$2,600 Second Huston Passed Unanimously

Current Contract

Discussion of semi-annual payments from townships. This is working fine.

Purchases in 2021

Total Capital Expenditures were \$25,469 in 2021. These funds were spent on equipment including Thermal Imaging Camera, garage door openers, radio batteries, Blitzfire, and fire hoses.

Projects and Purchases for 2022

Fire Department is still considering an addition to the existing fire hall in order to save cost and meet the needs of the department. Wells Concrete has offered approximately 30% off their material cost. Fire Department is looking at an expansion in the near future, but is also planning to make sure there is opportunity for further expansion in many years to come.

Membership

Currently there are 26 fully trained members. Twenty-eight total members. Two new hires in 2021 – Ryan Morse and Brendan Merkling. New hires are required to be certified in FFI & FFII, HazMat Operations Level 1, Behind the Wheel Training, CPR, EMR, Defib, and King Airway. Expecting one retirement summer of 2022.

Fundraisers Planned

Spunk Days Raffle (average of \$9,000 per year) Golf Outing (average of \$20,000 per year) Calendar Ads (average of \$7,500 per year) There was discussion about some problems with the calendars being printed incorrectly. Chief Richter expressed his disappointment in the printing issues and will follow up on them. The department will continue fundraising efforts to support department purchases and needs.

2021 FEMA Grant

The department is not planning to apply for a 2021 grant.

2021 Calls and Financial Report

There were 283 total calls in 2021 totaling 3228 hours.

Avon City = 124 calls (1331 hours)

Collegeville Twp = 29 calls (325 hours)

Avon Twp = 96 calls (1039 hours)

I-94 = 27 calls (358 hours)

Mutual Aid = 7 calls (175 hours)

Fire Department General Expenses for 2020 were \$92,476
