Avon Township Special Meeting regarding Road project on 165<sup>th</sup>. May 21, 2009 Avon City Hall

The special meeting was called to order by Renee Smith, township clerk at 7:00pm. We began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Adam Ripple explained the purpose for the meeting. According to the law, before beginning a road project where property owners where land areas may be altered or used in construction, we must conduct a public meeting to inform residents of the project and any changes of his property which will affect the land owner.
